1st Visit: 6-8 Weeks of Age

Complete Physical Exam
1st Distemper/Parvo/Parainfluenza/Hepatitis Vaccine
Deworming for Roundworms and Hookworms
Fecal Exam to Check for Intestinal Parasites
Nail Trim

2nd Visit: 3 Weeks After 1st Visit

Complete Physical Exam, free dose of Heartworm prevention
2nd Distemper/Parvo/Parainfluenza/Hepatitis Vaccine
Deworming for Roundworms and Hookworms
Fecal Exam to Check for Intestinal Parasites
Nail Trim

3rd Visit: 3 Weeks After 2nd Visit

**** ADDITIONAL LIFESTYLE VACCINES****

→ Lyme Vaccine- Recommended for living in a wooded area and for hunting/camping (Lyme Disease is transmitted by ticks)
→ Lepto Vaccine- Recommended for exposure to wildlife or standing water (Lepto is contagious to humans)
→ Bordetella (Kennel Cough) Vaccine- Recommended for going to the groomer or a kennel

COMFORT AND CARE PACKAGE FOR SURGERIES

These options are designed to provide maximum protection and comfort for your pet

→ Pre-Surgical Blood Screen (\$65.25)

- This blood panel helps to detect internal problems such as kidney or liver disease, which can pose an anesthetic risk to your pet.

→ Intradermal Sutures (\$21.00)

- These sutures are buried underneath the skin and help to reduce the likelihood of your pet licking the incision and causing infection. With these sutures, there is no need for you to come back to have sutures removed.

→ Cardiac Monitor (\$12.50)

- Although we do monitor all pets during surgery, our EKG device allows the constant monitoring of your pet's vital signs during surgery. Unexpected changes in heart rate and/or respiratory rate are able to be immediately addressed.

→ IV Line and Fluids (\$23.50)

- Having an IV line and fluids better helps us to maintain your pet's blood pressure during surgery. Also, in an emergency situation, having the IV catheter in place saves valuable time.

→ Post Op Pain Medication (\$25.00-\$45.00, depending on the weight of your pet)

- This provides long lasting protection from pain for your pet, for up to 12 hours, following your pet's surgery.
